

# How Will Title I Portability Impact Your Community?

**What will happen to my neighborhood public school system when my community has an exodus from the public schools into charter and religious/private schools with my tax money attached to that child?**

**Why does ESEA expand charter schools and not expand funding and services for my public school?**

**How will ESEA totally restructure the financial and taxing entities that must be changed in my local community and in my state to enact Title I Portability and equity? What laws must be changed? What impact will this have on state's rights controlling the purse strings?**

**How will ESEA restructure government to transfer power from legally elected officials that now hold jobs within local, county, and state offices?**

**What will happen to my locally elected school board members, who are my tax representatives, if my public school can not financially support the district after the exodus of students? What will happen to public school buildings that belong to the taxpayers.**

**What will happen to property values if Title I Portability eliminates the notion of going to a better school or zip code when all children will be funded the same and no school can be better than any other? Will all teachers be paid the same, too?**

**What impact will Title I Portability have in the economic balance in your town between losing school taxes and local jobs, for example; the impact to real estate agencies, appraisers, and agents, banking industry and loans, jobs in locally elected offices, teachers formally employed by public schools, malls and large development companies who pay large amounts of school taxes? What replaces school taxes?**

**NOTE: Title I Portability will socialize America. If the Reauthorization of ESEA passes with Title I Portability as noted....be prepared for a tsunami of political oppression. Public schools as we know them, will experience a downward spiral.**

**The obvious conclusion is that we no longer will have elected representatives in our local school district. The impact of the overlap of dissolution of elected local, county and state officials remains to be seen. Our tax money, no longer based on property to enhance equity, will be pooled toward a regionalized entity or economic authority controlled from the state that has collected the individual, longitudinal data so that funding will be distributed equally for each child. No one is sure what will happen to property values when the transfer of power is wrested away from landowners and elected officials.**

**Charter schools privately owned and publicly funded, and private schools receiving Title I children, will replace public education under the auspice of an outside third party authorizer, accredited and considered a contract school. If schools and teachers are not teaching Common Core non-academic standards, they will be identified and teachers fired and replaced with younger, submissive, compliant accomplices. Teachers will be contracted by the state on a list of prospective positions, but they will apply through the school district.**

**Charter schools will break the back of unions. We can expect to experience multiple school closings in all major cities and towns as a direct result of Title I choice programs. Governors, mayors, Senators, and Representatives from both red and blue states will contribute to this downfall by not capping the number of charter schools. When public schools fail, charter schools using public funds are there to take their place. A charter school will just come in and take over the public school building and property using your hard earned tax money without your voice and without your vote.**
